Students have direct access to the members of Anti-ragging authority. Student suggestion box is placed at various places in the college. The complaints received from the student or any kind of harassment in campus is forwarded to the Anti-Ragging Cell. The members of the cell meet twice in the session or as per the requirement of the action to be taken against any grievance or trouble. The issue is discussed and resolved according to its intensity. An annual report is prepared by the Anti-Ragging cell and it is forwarded to the Principal of the college.

### **Punishment in the event of ragging:**

On receipt of the recommendation of the Anti-Ragging Squad or on receipt of any information concerning any reported incident of ragging, the Head of Institution shall immediately proceed to file a First Information Report (FIR), within twenty four hours of receipt of such information or recommendation, with the police and local authorities, the Anti-Ragging Committee may, depending on the nature and gravity of the guilt established by the Anti-Ragging Squad, award, to those found guilty, one or more of the following punishments, namely;

- i. Suspension from attending classes and academic privileges.
- ii. Withholding/ withdrawing scholarship/ fellowship and other benefits.
- iii. Debarring from appearing in any test/ examination or other evaluation process.
- iv. Withholding results.
- v. Suspension/ expulsion from the hostel.
- vi. Cancellation of admission.
- vii. Rustication from the Institution for period ranging from one to four semesters. etc
